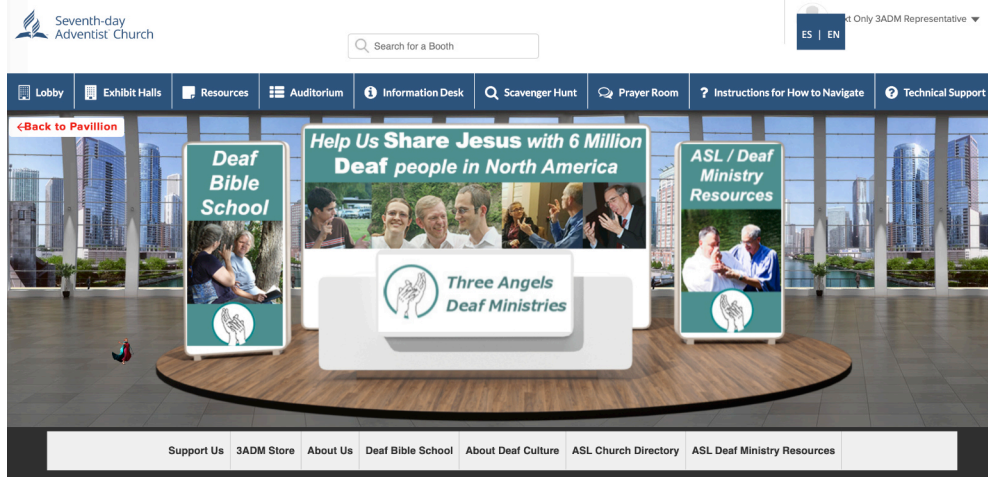




Adventist Virtual Global Camp Meeting 2021

The Speaker's Message: Hacked!

Have you experienced someone hacking your email address or making a new email address with your name that you never used (imposter) to fool your friends? I have received some emails that were hacked fooling us to think they were from our friends, but our friends didn't know about it until we told them. I felt sorry for our friends, but a month ago our friends felt sorry for me.

One weekend we were getting away from our home (suburb environment) by going to the rural eastern shore of Maryland where we visited the Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge. You know that for a year many people have been staying home due to COVID-19. Now, it was a good time for us to be in the country to enjoy God's nature. As we were driving closer to the refuge I got a text message from one of the Deaf church members asking me if it was me who sent him an email. It was a short text message and I told him, "No," because I knew I didn't send to him. I thought it was strange, but I quickly forgot about it as I was too focused on getting into the refuge as soon as possible. In fact, while on any birding trips we have been trying to avoid texting and emailing for a day. But, after spending a wonderful day of bird sighting (we saw a new species for our record) Francisca received several urgent texts and emails from our friends that they got the "messages from me" who asked for money to support a charity. They were not sure if it was me or not. That stopped me! It spoiled my day, but fortunately we were almost done with the birding for the day as the sun was sinking in the west. On the trip back to home I was worried that a hacker might have broken into my computer and stole all of my information. Because of it I had wild imaginations swirling in my mind until we arrived home. At home I checked my email account but there was nothing wrong with it. Also, I checked our bank accounts and there was nothing missing. I was puzzled. Some of my friends received my "email" asking for money. I was embarrassed by this scamming scheme. Quickly, I warned all of the people in my address book about the scammed email that wasn't from me. Some of them responded with sympathy and they understood that it was not from me. But only a few of them were surprised that I dared to ask for money. I was innocent of this crime.

This experience has taught me an important spiritual lesson. We all have been scammed by Satan all the time. Satan is the chief hacker of

God's Word and people's minds with false teachings to deceive the world. Most people, especially Christians, believe in the wrong ideas about God and His teachings. For example, most Christians believe that Sunday comes from the Bible. Actually, there is no such word as Sunday in the Bible. And, they believe that wicked people who died have suffered in hell forever. The Bible doesn't say that. Some people hate God because of the false teachings about hell and death. Satan knows the Bible very well and he uses it to twist meanings of God's messages such as to give the world the wrong ideas about our wonderful God. Satan is an accuser and liar. He wants all of the world to hate God through hacking God's email, the Bible. Also, Satan skillfully influences people's minds to think that God is a cruel person. Satan can control people's mind easily if the people do not know the Bible and if they have rejected the truth.

Jesus knew about Satan's plan to hack the truth about God. He graciously volunteered to come down here to be a man like us but without sin to serve the people who needed to know the truth about God. Be ready at all times, and tell people what they need to do. Tell them when they are wrong. Encourage them with great patience and careful teaching, because the time will come when people will not listen to the true teaching but will find many more teachers who please them by saying the things they want to hear. They will stop listening to the truth and will begin to follow false stories"

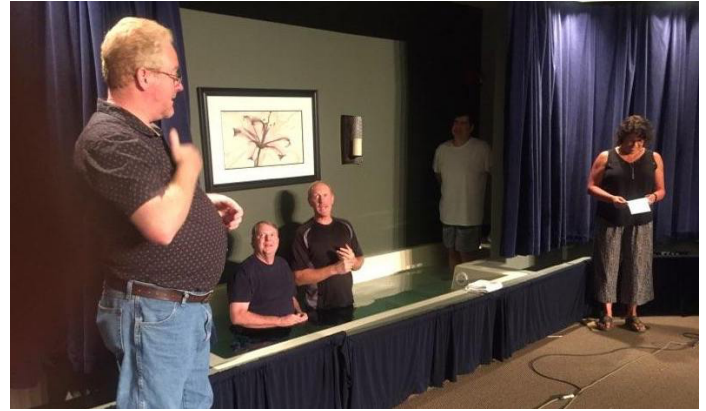
