A New 3ADM Promo DVD Is Coming Soon!



The new and updated 3ADM promo DVD, *Reaching the Deaf*, is completed. Soon it will be released to the public. This is the third promo DVD since the first one came out back in 2002.

This first promo DVD was created a few years after the incorporation of Adventist Deaf Ministries (the former name) in 1998.

Since 1980 Christian Record Services/Department of Deaf had served the Deaf until it was closed in 1997. So the first promo DVD was created to bring attention to the church and Deaf members about ADM (now 3ADM) that filled in the gap to continue the ministry to the Deaf in SDA Church. The theme of the DVD was "Why a Special Ministry to Deaf People?" It had touched the hearts of many hearing members to support ADM.

But, of course time has changed and the new staff and new organization's name

to 3ADM called for us to have a new DVD. The second was created called *Reaching the Deaf*. It showed the real life of Deaf members and people who are having difficulty in receiving the message in church and facing obstacles in church. It gives a broad picture of how Deaf members and non-members face in the real world of sound that is used to spread the gospel.

This DVD was produced in around 2008, and now it has become dated so we need to produce another promo DVD that offers up-to-date information and better presentation to the church about the importance of having 3ADM that is working closely with the Seventh-day Adventist Church. This time this DVD makes emphasis on language as the main reason for the existence of the vital ministry. Our language is ASL that results in creating a "nation" of Deaf people. This group of people is easily overlooked and marginalized in the church so we hope that the new DVD will help the church members to be sensitized and be willing to support 3ADM that can effectively spread the gospel to Deaf people.

Speaker's Dialogue: Why Did the Great Aztec Empire Fall?

The Aztec Empire in Mexico was a powerful Indian tribe that ruled the area where Mexico City is located today. The Aztecs had the tradition that "Quetzal-coatl the white," a kind and gracious god, who had come to earth to teach the people the truth. He would return after many years, and lead them to a land that was the place of the gods, a place of eternal and highest happiness.

In the 16th century a Spanish leader, Hernán (Hernando) Cortés, lead his soldiers from the coast of Mexico to the interior. When the Aztec king saw Cortés he thought he was the white god who would come back again according to the tradition. Many Aztecs believed Cortés and his soldiers were descendants of the White God because Cortés and his soldiers were white and bearded. They showed respect for Cortés. But, Cortés took an advantage of their beliefs to fool them. Because of the deception the Aztec empire was destroyed in a short time.

Will we be like the Aztec king who was fooled by the "White god?" Unfortunately, most Christians of the world will be deceived by what they believe to be Jesus because of false teachings that the Bible does not teach. For example, almost all Christian churches have accepted the false idea of Jesus' second coming. We, the Adventists, don't believe in the secret rapture. Most people of the world, Christians, Muslim, Hindu, Buddhists, secular-minded, and non-religious will be deceived by the false Christ because they don't know and understand the Bible that is warning us to not to believe in the false Christ and false prophets. "For false christs and false prophets will arise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. Listen, I have told you beforehand" (Matthew 24:24, 25).

But, are we Adventists safe from the Satan's deception? We know the truth but we can be deceived easily if we are not prepared right now. We have the truth but we can be deceived anyway. Jesus warned us that Satan is using false christs and false prophets to deceive God's people as much as possible. We are in the world of deception and pleasure that we are seeing, reading, feeling, and hearing every day. If we

are not careful or watchful we can be influenced by social media, Internet, music, friends, etc. They can "teach" us the "truth" that confuses us easily if we are not careful and watchful with the word of God, the Bible. I know some of our Adventist friends who are fooled by the Internet and social media on the nature of God, the wrong misunderstanding information about Ellen G. White, the spiritual formative, gifts of tongue, and even secret rapture! Here is a quote from the Spirit of Prophecy as a warning to us.

"At every revival of God's work, the prince of evil [Satan] is aroused to more activity. He is now using his efforts for the final battle against Christ and His followers. The last great deception is soon to open before us. Antichrist will do his marvelous works in our sight. So closely will the counterfeit [false copy] look the same as the true, that it will be impossible to see the difference between them if we do not depend on the Holy Scriptures. By their testimony every statement and every miracle must be tested by the Bible. . .

"People who have fortified the mind with the truths of the Bible will stand through the last great conflict. But, if they don't know and love the truths of the Bible they will fail in the last conflict. To every person will come the searching test: Shall I obey God rather than men? The decisive hour is even now. Are we standing on the rock of God's unchangeable word? Are we prepared to stand firm in defense of the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus?" (Maranatha, page 94).

Brothers and sisters in Christ, now it is the time for all of us to give up our own human's opinions and ways. Often, we sincerely tend to think we are right but wrong in God's eyes. We need to let the Bible to test our thinking and action every day to see if we are obeying the words of God, even in little thing. God is testing us to see if we are honest with Him and others even in small things of life. If we fail in small things then we will fail in big things. So, let us not be fooled and destroyed like the great Aztec king.

ASL Bible Dictionary was discussed and dreamed of for a long time until 2017 when a group of Deaf members decided to have a meeting at the Western Deaf Camp Meeting. That meeting was the starting point for developing the ASL Bible Dictionary for Adventist Deaf members to use for worship services and for the interpreters who wish to know appropriate signs for different religious words. For each word the members gave the signs and agreed upon one. There were some regional ASL to be considered. The meeting was productive. The original goal was to use less initialized sign language for the commonly used Biblical terms. Replacing every initialized sign with more natural non-initialized sign was not as easy as expected. After the meeting they started the first fifty words to film with at least five different actors.

That was some progress, but they only use a third of our vocabulary listed. Also, unfortunately, each person wore different clothes that were not appropriate for videoing. In other word it was unprofessional.

In 2019 after a long hung up of the work and a downsizing of the committee they decided to improve the quality of the video by choosing appropriate clothing. Consequently, they decided to re-do all of the videos of the actor with the better choice of clothing for the sake of professional appearance. That was the primary reason they are doing recording recently.
