
I am hopeful for the success of the upcoming interview, as it has the potential to raise awareness about the unique needs

3ADM's ASL Video Project Led by Farrah Gooding-Santiago 🤦

I am excited to announce that Three Angels Deaf Ministries (3ADM) has chosen Farrah Gooding-Santiago to lead a significant video project: transforming God's Way Bible lessons into American Sign Language (ASL). We expect this project to be completed by 2025.

Every January, around 22 million Seventh-day Adventists (SDA) from all over the world come together in a special event that lasts for ten days. During this time, they connect deeply, pray with all their hearts, and find new energy. Each day has its own theme, and this year's theme is "Priorities of Faith — Christian Virtue in Troubled Times" (Micah 6:8). For Deaf Adventists, this event is very meaningful.

This year, Sheelah Kimbrough and Nicolette Reynoso organized a ten days Zoom gathering on behalf of the <u>Deaf Adventist Evangelical Fellowship (DEAF) SDA Church</u>. It took place from January 10th to the 20th and had over 70 Deaf and hard-of-hearing Adventists participating from the United States and other countries. The Ten Days of Prayer Readings and Guides were translated into Easy Reading English so that everyone could join in and connect with God.

Each day of prayer had a different focus, guiding us through prayers of reflection, adoration, devotion, renewal, and the sharing of touching stories that showed how God's love changes lives. We also sang beautiful songs together at the end of each prayer session, making our connection with God even stronger.

Here are the themes for each day:

Day 1: Less Busy is More Blessing (Ephesians 5:15-16)

Day 2: The Danger of Being Busy for God (Mark 6:30-32)

Day 3: The Blessing of Waiting (Psalm 46:10)

Day 4: The Freedom of a Focused Life of Simplicity (Matthew 6:16-18)

Day 5: Focusing on Things That Matter in Our Prayers (Matthew 6:9-10)

Day 6: Toughness, Strong Desire, and Not Giving Up (Galatians 6:9)

Day 7: The Value of Kindness (John 13:35)

Day 8: Practicing an Attitude of Thankfulness (Hebrews 12:28)

Day 9: The Blessing of the Sabbath (Isaiah 58:13)

Day 10: Be Rich in What is Important- Be Less Online and More in-Person (Hebrews 10:24)

On the special Sabbath day of January 20th, Boyd Garner shared a powerful sermon that tied all these themes together, reminding us that our Christian faith is meant to be lived together with other believers. Encouraging and supporting each other are important parts of our faith journey.

Alan enjoyed meeting the people a lot. We handed out many materials, including "The Life Story of Jesus" DVD, with Alan Meis as the narrator. His picture is on the back cover of the DVD. Some people didn't realize they had just met Alan until we told them, and they were surprised to see him standing right there at the booth. It led to a good laugh.

We had about 18 individuals sign up for the Bible study course. Please keep them in your prayers, that they may find their way to Jesus and His amazing truth. After the expo, we went to Lou Malnati's Pizzeria and were surprised to see many Deaf people at almost 10 tables. The waiters did a great job serving them.

With all that said, DeafNation plans to host another expo in the same city this coming November.


