Are You Ready?

Theme

Matthew 24:42 (NKJV)

Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming.

Lesson

- Jesus tell us to watch!
- Jesus tell us three parables so we know how to watch!

Parable #1

- About 10 virgins - wise and foolish
- We must have oil = Holy Spirit!
- Not once but always!
- We must let Holy Spirit have full control of our lives!

Parable #2

- Teach us what to do while we are waiting for Jesus to come back!
- We must go to work using our talents to gain souls!
- If we use our talents we WILL win!
- If we not use talents we WILL lose!

Parable #3

- The Sheep and the Goats
- Teach us what work to do with our talents!
- I will sign the verses but you can read for yourself if you want.

Matthew 25:31-46

The Son of Man will come again in his great glory, with all his angels. He will be King and sit on his great throne. All the nations of the world will be gathered before him, and he will separate them into two groups as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats.

The Son of Man will put the sheep on his right and the goats on his left. Then the King will say to the people on his right, "Come, my Father has given you his blessing. Receive the kingdom God has prepared for you since the world was made.

I was hungry, and you gave me food. I was thirsty, and you gave me something to drink. I was alone and away from home, and you invited me into your house. I was without clothes, and you gave me something to wear. I was sick, and you cared for me. I was in prison, and you visited me.”

house?”

When did we see you without clothes and give you something to wear? When did we see you sick or in prison and care for you?” Then the King will answer, “I tell you the truth, anything you did for even the least of my people here, you also did for me.”

Matthew 25:31-46

Then the King will say to those on his left, "Go away from me. You will be punished. Go into the fire that burns forever that was prepared for the devil and his angels. I was hungry, and you gave me nothing to eat.

Matthew 25:31-46

I was thirsty, and you gave me nothing to drink. I was alone and away from home, and you did not invite me into your house. I was without clothes, and you gave me nothing to wear. I was sick and in prison, and you did not care for me.”

Matthew 25:31-46

Then those people will answer,
“Lord, when did we see you hungry
or thirsty or alone and away from
home or without clothes or sick or
in prison? When did we see these
things and not help you?”

Matthew 25:31-46

Then the King will answer, "I tell you the truth, anything you refused to do for even the least of my people here, you refused to do for me."

These people will go off to be punished forever, but the good people will go to live forever.

Lesson

- What work we do with our talents?
- Help people!
- Be kind!

If we would humble ourselves before God, and be kind and courteous and tenderhearted and pitiful, there would be one hundred conversions to the truth where now there is only one.

Lesson

- I believe parable is both real and spiritual!
- We need to give hungry people real food, thirsty people real water!
- Give real clothes and visit people sick and in prison!

Lesson

- But also spiritual!
- We need to give people the Bread of Life (Jesus) and the Water of Life (Jesus) and the Robe of Righteousness (Jesus).

Lesson

- We need to bring people into the House of God (church).
- We need to help people out of the sickness and prison of sin!

Lesson

- If we help people with their real needs, then they will be more open to their spiritual needs!
- If we become friends with people, then we can introduce them to our best friend, Jesus!

Lesson

- When we help people, we are helping Jesus.
- When we are kind to people, we are kind to Jesus.

Lesson

- But if we not help people, then we not help Jesus!
- If we not kind to people, then we not kind to Jesus!
